Simplify your short game

Reap the rewards of great wedge play

Over the past three weeks, we have discussed the importance of great distance control in your wedge game and how it can help you lower your scores, improve your skills and get more from your golf.

Create a wedge chart.

There are many advantages:

- Greater distance control
 - Improved accuracy
- Better shot execution under pressure
- Added confidence from a variety of distances
 - Less technical swing thoughts
 - Better game management.

Wedge	Swing length	Yardage
60°	9 - 3	23m
60°	11 - 1	64m
60°	Full	92m
55°	9 - 3	32m
55°	77 - 7	98m
55°	Full	108m
50°	9 - 3	40m
50°	11 - 1	110m
50°	Full	122m
PW	9 - 3	43m
PW	11 - 1	118m
PW	Full	130m

Armed with your wedge chart and your favorite distance with your favorite wedge, you'll know where to lay-up if you can't get to the green with your approach. That's better game management. Every golfer, whatever their handicap, should have a wedge chart.



Better ball striking
