Over the past few weeks we have been talking about how drivers have improved and I'm sure you would all agree that we could all

you the minimum amount of spin on the ball to maximize your driving distance.

If you are struggling to strike the ball consistently, you might want to consider getting a driver with a larger hitting zone to deliver a more consistent result on your tee shots.

The centre of gravity of your driver also plays a very important role in how every shot feels and at what loft the ball comes off the face after contact. This will have a huge impact on the height of your drive as well as the total amount of roll you get on the fairways.

Taking all of these factors into play to hit a perfect drive, we can easily see how important it is to have a driver custom fitted to you


